Choate Park Playground Project:

Trails: Jim Wieler

The committee was briefed on the status of the trails. The use of the Briggs land to the south of Adams Street as an area for brush storage logging and soil harvesting was also discussed. This parcel lays between Town owned parcels and should be a target for Open Space acquisition. Paul Harkey is Mr. Brigg's agent for the land north of Adams Street that is required for the trail easement. Discussions are continuing.
