DRIVEWAY SPECIFICATIONS REQUEST

Adopted May 9, 1988

Excerpt:

HEREBY, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF STERLING,
set down the following regulations:

All driveways must have a minimum width of 25 feet at the entrance and 20 feet minimum width throughout the driveway. Said 20 feet shall be a flat surface and free of stumps, trees, brush, rocks, etc. A minimum height clearance of 18 feet is required. Any curves in the driveway must not be less than 100 feet radius. Driveways exceeding 150 feet in length must provide an adequate turnaround that will accommodate a 30 foot long fire truck. If a circle drive is constructed, it must have a radius of no less than 45 feet to the center line. Otherwise, the turnaround area shall not be less than 60 feet by 60 feet. Private roads shall be the same as our town roads.

SECTION 1: Effective June 1, 1988, no new driveway may be constructed unless it meets the specifications of this ordinance.

SECTION 3: Definitions. (1) "Driveway is every way or place in private ownership used for vehicular travel to gain access to a public road from a dwelling. (2) "Dwelling" means any structure all or part of which is designated or used for human habitation.
