

**Ordinance to Lower Speed Limit on Town Highway
Town of Sterling
Polk County, Wisconsin**

The town board of the Town of Sterling, Polk County, Wisconsin, by this ordinance adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by roll call vote of a majority of the town board present and voting ordains and orders as follows:

Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective November 19, 2003, certain speed limits on certain Town of Sterling highways are reduced or modified as follows: Speed limit reduced by 10 mph (from 55 mph to 45 mph) on River Road from 250th Avenue south to Wolf Creek bridge.

The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described location by, on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
