WHEREAS, Black Lake is a 33-acre essential water body that provides for agriculture, tourism, fishing, recreation and an emergency backup drinking water source for the city; and

WHEREAS, in 2009 an extensive plant survey of the lake determined 97% of aquatic plant life in the lake was the invasive aquatic weed Brazilian elodea; and

WHEREAS, the city secured a grant from Department of Ecology to implement a multi-year, multiphased aquatic vegetation management plan to eradicate Brazilian elodea from Black Lake, protect the ecosystem and restore the lake's usability; and

WHEREAS, continuing community education and involvement are important elements in the control of aquatic invasive plant species.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Cassinelli, Mayor of the City of Ilwaco, Washington, do hereby proclaim the month of June 2013 as

STOP AQUATIC HITCHHIKERS MONTH

in the City of Ilwaco, Washington, and encourage the community to take action to stop new introductions and control the spread of aquatic invasive species.
