

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SPRING FIELD, MARQUETTE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, CREATING ORDINANCE NO. 88-1 OF THE TOWN OF SPRING FIELD, MARQUETTE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC AND BOATING ON THE WATERS OF TWIN LAKE AND PRESCRIBING FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

INTRODUCTION

WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of Springfield is aware of various problems present on Twin Lake involving pollution of the lake and surrounding areas, fire hazards, and sanitation problems.

WHEREAS the Town Board is aware of many large active springs, the ice conditions on Twin Lake are dangerous and it is in the best interest of public health and safety that the use of snowmobiles on the lake be prohibited.

AND WHEREAS the Town Board believes that these problems will be corrected by the restriction of activities on Twin Lake.

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of Springfield does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Regulation of Gasoline Powered Motor Traffic on Twin Lake.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a gasoline powered motor of any type in or on the waters of Twin Lake, including but not limited to motorboats and snowmobiles, except that the Town Board may authorize: 1- emergency vehicles and boats to be used on the lake only in the event of an emergency, and 2- all enforcement vehicles, including boats and snowmobiles, operated by persons acting in their official capacity enforcing the law shall have the right to go upon the lake at any time.

SECTION 2. Penalties.

- A. Any person who shall violate any of the above regulations shall forfeit not more than \$100.00 for the first offense, and shall forfeit not more than \$200.00 upon conviction of the same offense a second or subsequent time within one year.

SECTION 3.

- A. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication or posting, whichever occurs first.
