

ORDINANCE 88-2

Establishment of speed zones on Wood Lake Town Roads, Town of Springfield, Marquette County, State of Wisconsin.

The Town Board, Town of Springfield,, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A traffic and engineering investigation having been made on the following described highway, the maximum permissible speed at which vehicles may be operated on said highway which speed is herewith established as reasonable and safe pursuant to Sections 346.57 and 349.11, Wisconsin Statutes, Laws of 1987, shall be as set forth herein, subject to the erection of standard signs giving notice thereof.

Wood Lake Town Roads, Town of Springfield

- (a) Dakota Ct. (West). Twenty-five miles per hour for all vehicles from its intersection with C.T.H. "CH", easterly to its intersection with 5th Drive.
- (b) Dakota Ct. (South). Twenty-five miles per hour for all vehicles from its intersection with C.T.H. "CH", northerly to its terminus.
- (c) Dakota Avenue. Twenty-five miles per hour for all vehicles from its intersection with C.T.H. "CH", easterly to its intersection with Becker Road.
- (d) Becker Road. Twenty-five miles per hour for all vehicles from its intersection with C.T.H. "CH", northerly to its intersection with Dakota Avenue.
- e) 5th Drive. Fifteen miles per hour for all vehicles from its intersection with C.T.H. "CH", northerly to its intersection with Dakota Avenue.

Section 2. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than \$30 nor more than \$300.

Section 3. Any and all ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
