

ORDINANCE NO. 89-1

The town board of the Town of Springfield, Marquette County, does ordain as follows;

It is in the best interest of the public, and the Town of Springfield, to require a licensed business to continue in operation as a condition of keeping and renewing a license.

A business that is open less than 3 months per year or a business that is not in active operation for 90 consecutive days is considered in violation of this ordinance, and subject to license discipline which could include suspension or revocation under the Wisconsin Statutes, current 125.12 or a successor section.

You indicated the town board had approved the idea of requiring a business to continue, in order to maintain their alcohol license. The terms of what constitutes a continuing business were not mentioned. Your board needs to consider and approve your exact written form before publication, which could be something along the lines of:

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
A business that is open less than NO months per year

OR  
A business that is not in active operation for NO consecutive ~~(weeks)~~ ~~(months)~~ blank is considered in violation of this ordinance, and subject to license discipline which could include suspension or revocation under the Wisconsin Statutes, current 125.12 or a successor section.

Also, you asked about the salary survey information held by W.T.A. At present the information is outdated. Next month starts a new term for most town officers, and the association office will be sending out forms to obtain new information. This should allow us to have a better statistical base to provide you with in the future. Any officer salary increase not previously approved would not take place until the commencement of the next term in April, 1990 (for some 5 man board members) or April, 1991.
