

RESOLUTION 2015- 03

A RESOLUTION FORWARDING THE Town of Springfield PLANNED LAND
USE MAP FOR INCLUSION IN THE UPDATED MARQUETTE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE
PLAN/FARMLAND PRESERVATION PLAN

WHEREAS, Marquette County in 2005 prepared a Comprehensive Plan, which included as one required component a Planned Land Use map representing a future vision for land use in the County, assembled through land use planning largely conducted at the town, village, and city level; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §66.1001, §91.10, and §91.14, Wis. Stats.; and direction from the State Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection; Marquette County is required to adopt an updated comprehensive plan and a farmland preservation plan by the end of 2015; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to integrate the updated farmland preservation plan into its updated Marquette County Comprehensive Plan as a single document; and

WHEREAS, a farmland preservation plan must, under Chapter 91, Wis. Stats., include a farmland preservation plan map identifying areas particularly suited for long-term preservation, called "farmland preservation areas;" and

WHEREAS, Marquette County has requested each town, city, and village review and update its Comprehensive Plan Planned Land Use map to reflect current community land use desires and, if desired, to include one or more "farmland preservation areas;" and

WHEREAS, the Town of Springfield has reviewed the attached Planned Land Use map and found that the Map depicts the current land use vision for the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Springfield requests inclusion of the attached Planned Land Use map in Marquette County's Comprehensive Plan/Farmland Preservation Plan.

ORDINANCE NO. 2005- 2**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
OF THE TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD, WISCONSIN.**

The Town Board of the Town of Springfield, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to sections 60.22(3) and 62.23(2) and (3) of Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Springfield is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2. The Town Board of the Town of Springfield has adopted and followed written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 3. The Plan Commission of the Town of Springfield, by a majority vote of the entire Commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document entitled "TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD COMPREHENSIVE PLAN," containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 4. The Town of Springfield has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of Wisconsin Statutes, and provided numerous other opportunities for public involvement per its adopted public participation strategy and procedures.

SECTION 5: The Town Board of the Town of Springfield, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD COMPREHENSIVE PLAN," pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of Wisconsin Statutes.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and publication/posting as required by law.
