

ORDINANCE

An ordinance to permit the use of certain portions of town roads by snowmobile.

The Town Board of the Town of Springfield, Marquette County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. The following portions of town roads located within the Township may be used by snowmobiles:

A. Eagle Avenue from CTH "A" to the Southeast corner of Section 6.

B. Dakota Avenue and Becker Road in the North 1/2 of Section 2.

C. 3rd Avenue along the entire section line of Sections 4 and 5.

D. Meadow Avenue in Section 9.

2. All statutes and ordinances as are presently in force or hereafter enacted for motor vehicles on said roadways shall apply to snowmobiles, their drivers, and their passengers.
