# RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LEAF GRANT AWARD AND APPROVING A PROPOSAL FOR PUBLIC ART

WHEREAS, the Village of Saranac Lake Board of Trustees recognizes the importance and impact of downtown, parks and recreation, and arts and culture in driving economic development and contributing to the quality of life in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Saranac Lake was awarded \$15,000 from the North Elba Community Enhancement and Advancement Fund (LEAF) for installation of public art at Prescott Park; and

WHEREAS, the Village issued a Request for Proposals for public art installations at Riverfront and Prescott Parks; and

WHEREAS, the Village received 36 proposals from artists; and

WHEREAS, members from each of the three Village Advisory Boards have reviewed the proposals and recommend that the \$10,000 be awarded to Steven Gutierrez for installation of public art at Prescott Park;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Village of Saranac Lake Board of Trustees hereby accepts the LEAF grant and the recommendation of the review committee and authorizes the Village Manager to execute a contract with Steven Gutierrez.

## STEVEN GUTIERREZ

Please accept my application for the Village Park Sculpture on the Saranac Lake call to artists to produce a sculpture that enhances the mission of the park. I too was inspired by the vision of Central Park and became a Public Artist and researcher of Public Space due to that gem.

My art is inspired more directly by nature and I hope to bring this to Saranac Lake. I chose not to propose a specific sculpture as I would like to visit the site if I am chosen as a finalist. This would allow me to understand the space better, but also to interact with the community.

However, I do have ideas for a possible structure of the public artwork. Currently, I am imagining a forest of oars. This would highlight the importance of the canoe culture of the lake. The details of the oars, including cutouts, etchings, colors and whimsical possibilities would be directed from my visit. I usually work in stainless steel due to its resilience to the seasons, and I imagine I would have this as the underlying material for any idea I might decide on.

Art should show the viewer the unseen within something visible in plain sight. Although I plan to create an inspiring work, I also expect to expose to the visitors what is important to the village. Given the opportunity, I hope to excite the visitors to this park by creating an innovative, and engaging artwork.
