YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO BOIL ALL WATER FOR DRINKING AND CULINARY PURPOSES. THIS ORDER IS BEING ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 1107 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW.

THIS ORDER IS BEING ISSUED TO THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS ONLY:

From the intersection of Broadway and Bloomingdale Avenue, along Bloomingdale Avenue to Depot Street, including all of Depot Street.

DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST. Bring all water to a rolling boil in a clean container, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using. You may also use bottled water certified by NYSDOH, or use water from a public water system approved by NYSDOH. Boiled or bottled water certified by NYSDOH should be used for drinking, making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth, and food preparation until further notice.

The Boil Water Order is being issued due to lack of water and/or water pressure because of a major water line break. A Boil Water Order is a required procedure when water service is disrupted and there is a loss of satisfactory water line pressure.

Consumers will be notified as soon as the Boil Water Order is rescinded. The Boil Water Order will remain in effect until the repairs are complete <u>and satisfactory coliform bacteria samples are collected on two consecutive days</u>.
