

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

Thank you to the Department of Public Works for their continuous efforts in making the Village of Saranac Lake safe during the winter.

When the flashing light is turned on at the Dorsey Street Parking lot, this means that there <u>can not</u> be any overnight parking due to the removal of snow! Other places you may park during this time: <u>Pontiac and Sears Municipal Lots</u>. Notice will be in the newspaper and posted online.



- Mt. Pisgah had 25 days of snowmaking, 18 days were totaled for skier days in January and a completion of the NYS lift inspection
