Request for Quotes: Seasonal Plantings

Introduction

The Village of Saranac Lake seeks quotes from local nurseries/garden centers to prepare 41 planters and supply materials for four (4) entry sign planters plus the Star Garden.

Scope of Work

- 1. The Village of Saranac Lake has **41 Earth Planters** that, once planted, are placed throughout downtown from late June through mid-October. Local businesses cover half of the cost for 33 of the planters and the Village pays the full cost for 8 planters.
 - a. Village delivers the Earth Planters to the vendor in the first week of June*.
 - b. Vendor prepares the planters with soil, fertilizer, and flowers.
 - vendor waters the planters for at least 1 week before they are moved to downtown.
 *Do not fill the well before the planters are transported. Watering should be from the top while in the care of the vendor.
 - d. Vendor sends invoices to 33 local business owners for the co-op planters.
 - e. Village transports planters from vendor to downtown locations the third week in June*.
 - f. Village transports planters from downtown to vendor in mid-October.
 - g. Vendor removes flowers and soil (recycling of soil is encouraged).
 - h. Vendor cleans planters for winter storage.
 - i. Village picks up the planters the last week in October and stores them for the winter.
- 2. Vendor will supply flowers, soil and fertilizer for the four (4) village entrance signs and the Star Garden at the intersection of River and Church Streets. The entrance signs and Star Garden are planted by volunteers.
 - a. Vendor will hold the materials until volunteers are ready to plant in early to mid-June*. Volunteers will pick up the materials.
 - b. Vendor will coordinate delivery of materials with Village Improvement Society.

^{*}Village transport is dependent upon the weather; Village will only provide transportation to/from vendors within the Saranac Lake area.

Specifications

- Flowers for Planters
 - a. Must be able to take full sun
 - b. Must be able to survive first frost
 - c. Must be hardy
 - d. No impatiens, potato vine, or shade/partial shade plants
 - e. Arrangement should be colorful, full and lush enough to fill the planters
 - f. No 6-packs or small plants; 4 to 4.5 inch material only
 - g. 7-8 plants per planter
 - h. Each planter should have a focal plant in the center
- 2. Soil and Fertilizer for Planters
 - a. Pro Mix BX or equivalent soil-less mixture
 - b. Time-release fertilizer to be added at time of planting
- 3. Earth Planters 41 planters are Earth Planter Model EPMV31-Urban Vase 31
 - a. Weight: 25 lbs.
 - b. Top outside diameter: 31 in.
 - c. Bottom diameter: 19 in.
 - d. Height: 25.75 in.
 - e. Planting tray depth: 13 in.
 - f. Water capacity: 18 gal.
 - g. Soil capacity: 3.2 cubic ft.
 - h. Weight per planter (with water and wet soil): 280+ lbs.
- 4. Flowers for Entrance Signs
 - a. Must be able to take full sun for 3 locations
 - b. 1 location is partial shade (suggest wax begonias and Dusty Miller)
 - c. Must be able to survive first frost
 - d. Must be hardy
 - e. 8 6-packs per sign
 - f. Size of entrance sign planters: approximately 12 in wide X 48 in long X 12 in deep
- 5. Flowers for Star Garden
 - a. 10 6-packs of tall blue ageratum
 - b. 20 6-packs of tall red salvia
 - c. 10 4-packs of white wave petunias
 - d. 1 pound of time release fertilizer (Osmacoate)
 - e. Area of Star Garden: The star garden has a baptiste plant, a perennial, planted in the middle of the star. Each of the 5 points of the star is 12' long, from the baptiste plant in the middle, and starts at 3' wide and tapers to 1' at the point.
