What is an LWRP?

- Land and water use plan
- Strategy to implement the program
- Addresses:
 - Development
 - Waterfront Access
 - Protecting Natural & Cultural Resources
 - Erosion and Flooding



LWRP Overview*

LWRP Benefits

- Attract appropriate development
- Protect waterfront and other valued resources
- Eligibility for further funding
- Establishes consensus
- Creates long-term partnerships (among Community-based organizations and state agencies)
- Provides a comprehensive framework for decision-making

LWRP Benefits

 Actions by federal and state agencies (permits, funding) must be consistent with your LWRP.







WAC Meetings
