
Public Open House #1 - April 26 & 28, 2022

The Village of Saranac Lake has begun the process of updating its Local Waterfront Revitalization Program Update (LWRP). An LWRP is a comprehensive land and water use program that expresses a long-term vision for the waterfront.

A Public Open House is being held to introduce the program, provide an overview of existing conditions and learn about needs and opportunities from the community. An in-person and virtual meeting option is available. The in-person meeting will be held concurrently with a workshop on the redesign of Baldwin Park on April 26, 2022. The public will have an opportunity to provide feedback through a series of stations in the auditorium. A virtual option will be held separately via Zoom on April 28. The information gathered from these activities will help to inform the preparation of the LWRP and shape the vision of the waterfront.

Draft Vision

"The Saranac Lake waterfront will be a destination, providing water access and amenities for all ages, abilities and income levels. Saranac Lake will leverage its unique location by improving public spaces, supporting water-based and waterdependent uses, and enhancing bicycle, pedestrian and blueway connections throughout the Village and region. The waterfront area will maintain a balance of development and resource protection through the implementation of green infrastructure techniques and best management practices."




