

Village of Cameron
Noxious Weeds and Growth Notice

Notice is hereby given to each person who owns, occupies or controls land in the Village of Cameron, Barron County, Wisconsin, to destroy all noxious weeds on such property before the plants bloom. All noxious weeds as defined in WI Statute 66.0407. In addition, as described in the Municipal Code Sec. 14 other vegetation, all weeds, grasses, and plants excluding trees and shrubs shall be kept cut to a height of not to exceed 12 inches and shall be controlled at such time and in such a manner as will prevent such plants from maturing to the bloom. If any owner or occupant fails to cut or otherwise properly destroy in due season and as provided in Ch. 14 of the Municipal Code any such weeds, the Village Weed Commissioner shall give five days written notice by mail to the owner or occupant of any lands upon which the weeds shall be growing. After which, the Village will proceed to destroy all such weeds and the cost thereof will be assessed as a tax upon the lands upon which such weeds are located pursuant to state law. **State Law reference—** *Nuisance weeds, Wis.
