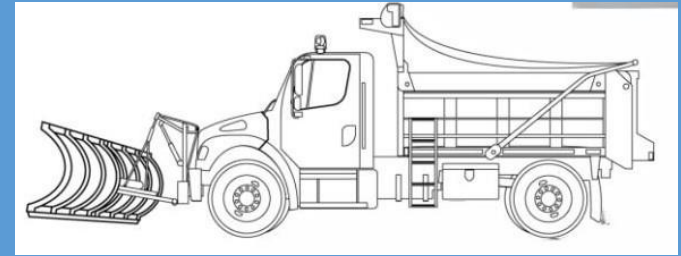


Snow Removal in the Village of Cameron



STREETS

REMOVAL TIMELINE
Begins at Snowfall

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Approximately 29.5 miles of streets including:

- Major arterial roads
- Collector roads
- Residential streets
- Cul-de-sacs
- Village Hall parking lots
- Cemetery roads
- 4 Lift stations
- 2 Well houses
- 2 Parks' parking lots



RESIDENTIAL SIDEWALKS

REMOVAL TIMELINE

Removal required within 24 hours after snow stops

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

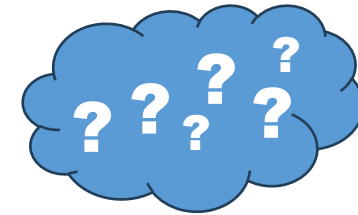
- Sidewalks in front of and along the sides of a home
- Adjacent mailboxes, where present
- Adjacent fire hydrants, where present

Refer to Ordinance Ch. 28, Article IV, Sec. 28-79



SNOW FACTS

- Cameron receives 40-50 inches of snow annually
- Snowiest months are: December, January, February
- The longest lasting snow events in Wisconsin:
 - ✓ 3 days of snow ending in 18-27"
 - ✓ 60 mph winds
 - ✓ snow drifts as high as 20 feet in 1947
