TRASH CANS, SNOWPLOWING, AND MAILBOXES



Residents are reminded that it is against the law to plow snow from your driveway across a public road.

Minnesota law and many local ordinances prohibit plowing, blowing, shoveling or otherwise placing snow onto public roads. This includes ditches and the right-of-way area along roads. Violations are considered misdemeanors, but civil penalties also apply if the placement of snow creates a hazard such as a slippery area, frozen rut or bump that contributes to a motor vehicle or pedestrian crash. The civil liability can extend to both the property owner and the person who placed the snow.

Trash cans should be placed at the end of your driveway, not on the street surface. On the street it makes it hard to meet other vehicles and can be in the way of getting snow plowed off the road.

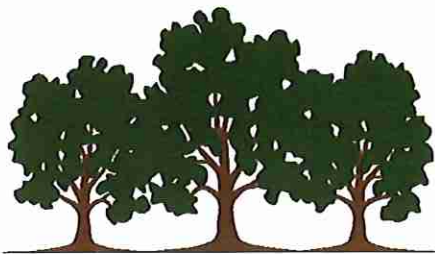
Your mailbox, protect it by knowing the rules. Mailbox installation is vital to its survival. Mailbox construction and installation is defined under MN Statute 160.2715. A post no larger than a wood 4x4 or a 2" diameter steel or aluminum post shall be used.

The height of the mailbox from the edge of the roadway to the bottom of the mailbox should be between 42" and 48".

Sherburne County can install an approved mailbox setting for residents that live along a county road for \$200, or sell a complete mailbox setting for \$75 with the resident performing the install.

Any Sherburne County resident can purchase through the County a complete setup for \$75 but the installation service is not provided.

Baldwin Township Residents that live on a Township Road may also purchase the swing away through the Township.
