
WHEREAS: The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) requires that states agree to operate and maintain facilities constructed with federal transportation funds for the useful life of the improvement and not change the use of right of way or property ownership acquired without prior approval from the FHWA; and

WHEREAS: Transportation Alternatives projects receive federal funding; and


WHEREAS: the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) has determined that for projects implemented with alternative funds, this requirement should be applied to the project proposer; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: Baldwin Township hereby agrees to assume full responsibility for the operation and maintenance of property and facilities related to the transportation alternatives project.

Adopted by the Baldwin Township Board on this 7th day of February 2022.








