MODEL RESOLUTION

THE TOWNSHIP OF BALDWIN

RESOLUTION No. 22-37

A RESOLUTION OPTING TO INCREASE THE BENEFIT LEVEL FOR FIREFIGHTERS WHO ARE VESTED IN THE STATEWIDE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER PLAN

The Township Board of the Township of Baldwin, Minnesota, does ordain:

WHEREAS: The Township previously authorized the fire department to join the Statewide Volunteer Firefighter Plan administered by the Public Employees Retirement Association (PERA); and

WHEREAS: The Township requested and obtained a cost analysis of increasing the benefit level for firefighters who are vested in the Statewide Volunteer Firefighter Plan from PERA not more than 120 days ago; and

WHEREAS: The Township understands that Minnesota statutes do not have provisions for a decrease in benefit levels; and

WHEREAS: The Township highly values the contributions of Township Fire Department members to the safety and well being of our community and wishes to safeguard their pension investments in a prudent manner.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BALDWIN, MINNESOTA:

- 1) The Township hereby approves an increase in the benefit level for firefighters who have completed at least 5 years of good time service credit as a member of the Statewide Volunteer Firefighter Plan administered by PERA at the \$4100 benefit level per year of service, effective January 1, 2023; and
- 2) The Township Clerk/Administrator and Township Board are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was proposed by Township Board and was duly seconded by Township Board and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor:




Whereupon said resolution was declared duly passed and adopted by the Township Board of the Township of Baldwin, on Nov. 21st, 2022.
