RESOLUTION DESIGNATING ANNUAL POLLING PLACE

WHEREAS, it is important that citizens exercise their right to vote at their local polling place;

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 204B.16 requires the Town Board to designate its local polling place for elections annually;

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 204B.16, subd. 3 allows township to designate one location for all state and federal elections and one location for all township only elections

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that as required by Minn. Stat. § 204B.45, the Town Board of Baldwin Township, Sherburne County, Minnesota does hereby designate the Baldwin Town Hall at 30239 – 128<sup>th</sup> Street in Sherburne County as its polling place for Precinct 1 for all state and federal elections in 2023.

Precinct 1 is defined as the area west of Highway 169.

AND

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that as required by Minn. Stat. § 204B.45, the Town Board of Baldwin Township, Sherburne County, Minnesota does hereby designate the Baldwin Maintenance Building for Precinct 2 at 30239 – 128<sup>th</sup> Street in Sherburne County as its polling place for Precinct 2 for all state and federal elections in 2023.


Precinct 2 is defined as the area east of Highway 169.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board of Baldwin Township, Sherburne County, Minnesota does hereby designate the Baldwin Town Hall, Precinct 1 at 30239 – 128<sup>th</sup> Street in Sherburne County as its polling place for all township selections in 2023.


