RESOLUTION APPLYING FOR GRANT WITH DNR

WHEREAS, the Township of Baldwin supports the grant application made to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources for the Federal Recreational Trail Program. The application is to construct 2 new miles and add 4 ½ miles to existing trails. The Young Park trail system is located within 5 miles of Princeton, MN and Goose Park is located within 7 miles of Zimmerman, MN, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Baldwin recognizes that it has secured \$93,750 in local matching funds for this project and must provide a twenty-five percent (25%) match for a total grant of \$125,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, if the Township of Baldwin is awarded a grant by the Minnesota Department of Natural resources, the Township of Baldwin agrees to accept the grant award and may enter into an agreement with the State of Minnesota for the above referenced project. The Township of Baldwin will comply with all applicable state and federal laws, environmental requirements and regulations as stated in the grant agreement, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant has read the Conflict-of-Interest Policy contained in the Trail Program Grant Manual and certifies it will report any actual, potential, or organizational conflicts of interest upon discovery to the state related to the application or grant award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Township of Baldwin names the fiscal agent for the Township of Baldwin for this project as:
