RESOLUTION NO. 23-13

**A RESOLUTION FINDING CERTAIN WORK TO BE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF
THE ROLE OF A SUPERVISOR AND AUTHORIZING THE WORK TO BE
PERFORMED ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN**

Minn. Stat. § 471.88, subd. 5.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (“Town Board”) of Baldwin Township (“Town” or “Township”) rely on a Town Supervisors to perform various tasks for the Town that the Town does not otherwise have staff to perform on their behalf and that are impractical to have performed by contractors because of the size or periodic nature of the work;

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 366.01, Subd. 1, reflects the broad roles that Town Supervisors play in the functioning of a Township by stating that Supervisors shall have charge of “all town affairs not committed to other officers by law”; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board hereby authorizes Town Supervisors to perform the following types of work for the Town as part of their supervisor duties for the Town as needed:

1. Miscellaneous items of work to keep the Town’s roads free of debris and fallen Trees, limbs, etc.
2. Inspect the roads and conduct sign surveys.
3. And other general labor


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, This Resolution is intended to clarify supervisor duties by listing the types of work in addition to the other tasks performed by supervisors, such as attending meetings, that are considered to be part of their duties for the Town, and is not a complete or exclusive list of those duties; payment for such services to occur upon the filing of a proper affidavit by the interested officer.
