RESOLUTION RELATING TO LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT AGREEMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR 100TH STREET AND 297TH AVENUE

WHEREAS, this resolution passed this 1st day of December, 2025, by the City of Baldwin in Sherburne County, Minnesota. The Municipal Corporation shall hereinafter be called the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) is established in Minnesota Statute 174.52; and,

WHEREAS, the legislature provided \$47,000,000 for LRIP in Laws of Minnesota with a cap of \$1,500,000 for each project; and,

WHEREAS, 100th Street from 289th Avenue (County Road 28) to 305th Avenue (County Road 38) is deficient and does not meet the minimum roadway requirements as outlined in Minnesota Rules 8820.9920; and,

WHEREAS, 297th Avenue from 108th Street (County Road 19) to 100th Street is deficient and does not meet the minimum roadway requirements as outlined in Minnesota Rules 8820.9920; and,

WHEREAS, 100th Street and 297th Avenue are roads that service as direct transportation between Sherburne County Roads 19, 28, and 38 for local traffic and are proposed to be reconstructed to a 10-ton standard; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Baldwin and its Engineer shall prepare the grant agreement, develop and deliver State Aid plans for the project, advertise, bid, and award the project, provide all construction services for the project, and close out the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN:

- 1. Hereby supports the project and agrees to maintain such improvements.
- 2. Authorizes the submittal of the LRIP application.
- 3. Agrees to pay all project costs not covered by the grant application.
- 4. Will provide construction observation and oversight to ensure the project is completed in conformance with the approved plans and specifications.
