**RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE MNDOT MASTER PARTNERSHIP CONTRACT**

**WHEREAS**, this resolution passed this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2025, by the City of Baldwin in Sherburne County, Minnesota. The Municipal Corporation shall hereinafter be called the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Minnesota Department of Transportation wishes to cooperate closely with local units of government to coordinate the delivery of transportation services and maximize the efficient delivery of such services at all levels of government; and,


**WHEREAS**, MnDOT and local governments are authorized by Minnesota Statutes sections 471.59, 174.02, and 161.20, to undertake collaborative efforts for the design, construction, maintenance and operation of state and local roads; and,

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to be able to respond quickly and efficiently to such opportunities for collaboration, and have determined that having the ability to write "work orders" against a master contract would provide the greatest speed and flexibility in responding to identified needs.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN:**

1. That the City of Baldwin enter into a Master Partnership Contract with the Minnesota Department of Transportation, a copy of which was before the Council.
2. That the proper City officers are authorized to execute such contract, and any amendments thereto.
3. That the City Engineer is authorized to negotiate work order contracts pursuant to the Master Contract, which work order contracts may provide for payment to or from MnDOT, and that the City Engineer may execute such work order contracts on behalf of the City of Baldwin without further approval by this Council.
