RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-5

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AMONG PUBLIC ENTITIES REGARDING THE COMMUNITY RENEWABLE ENERGY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in 2019 the Utah Legislature passed the Utah Community Renewable Energy Act, which authorized the Utah Public Service Commission to establish a community renewable energy program whereby municipalities may cooperate with qualified utilities to provide electric energy for participating customers entirely from renewable energy resources; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Alta adopted Resolution 2019-R-16, establishing a goal of achieving an amount equivalent to 100% of the annual electric energy supply for participating customers in the Town of Alta from a renewable energy resource by 2030 and beginning the process of fulfilling the Utah Community Renewable Energy Act's program requirements; and

WHEREAS, 22 Utah communities joined Alta in adopting similar resolutions in 2019 and are working together to develop and implement the Community Renewable Energy Program (C-REP); and

WHEREAS, these communities collaborated to develop an agreement for governance of C-REP, also known as Utah 100 Communities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Utah Community Renewable Energy Act, communities electing to participate in C-REP are responsible for paying the costs associated with developing and implementing the renewable energy program being defined through C-REP;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Town Council of the Town of Alta hereby adopts the attached Interlocal Agreement Among Public Entities Regarding the Community Renewable Energy Program and authorizes the mayor of the Town of Alta to execute the same on behalf of the Town of Alta.
