NOTICE: INTERLODGE CLOSURES

Alta Town Ordinance 5-4-2

Avalanches are a natural and dangerous occurrence in Little Cottonwood Canyon. To lessen this hazard, avalanche control work is conducted in Alta and surrounding areas.

During these activities and periods of increased avalanche danger, outdoor travel restrictions known as **INTERLODGE CLOSURES** are put into effect.

When Interlodge closures are in effect, all persons are required to remain inside of a building away from windows, decks, and other vulnerable areas until the closure has been lifted. Violations are prosecuted by the Alta Marshals Office. More importantly, loss of life or serious injury can occur.

Alta Central Dispatch makes notifications to all businesses and residents located within town boundaries when Interlodge restrictions are initiated and lifted.

Preparedness is important. At times, in extreme conditions, Interlodge closures may remain in effect for several days. Adequate supplies of food, prescription medications, and other necessary items are essential.

Restrictions in the Snowbird area may differ from those in effect for the Town of Alta. Outdoor travel may only be resumed after notification from Alta Central.

Alta Town Ordinance requires posting of this notice at all building exits to inform residents and visitors of this critical situation.
