RESOLUTION 2026-R-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ALTA ACKNOWLEDGING THE FILING OF THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-27 SUBMITTED BY THE MAYOR AND PREPARED BY THE BUDGET OFFICER PURSUANT TO SECTION 10-5-107 OF THE UTAH CODE; ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET SUBJECT TO FURTHER REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION BY THE COUNCIL; ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME, AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE TENTATIVE BUDGET PRIOR TO ADOPTION OF THE FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-27 SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTIONS 59-2-919 AND 59-2-924 OF THE UTAH CODE; ORDERING PUBLICATION OF NOTICES AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND ORDERING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET TO BE AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION IN THE OFFICE OF THE TOWN CLERK AND ON THE TOWN'S WEBSITE FOR AT LEAST 10 DAYS PRIOR TO ADOPTION OF THE FINAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, under Section 10-5-107 of the Utah Code, the Mayor shall submit prepare for the ensuing year a tentative budget for each fund for which a budget is required, make the tentative budget available for public inspection, and submit the tentative budget to the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, under Section 10-5-107 of the Utah Code, on receipt of the tentative budget, the Council shall review, consider, and adopt the tentative budget subject to further amendment or revision by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Officer has prepared the tentative budget for fiscal year 2026-27 (the "Tentative Budget") as required by law and has submitted the Tentative Budget to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council acknowledges receipt of the Tentative Budget prepared by the Budget Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to review, consider, and adopt the Tentative Budget prepared and submitted by the Budget Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to review and make any changes to the Tentative Budget as the Council deems appropriate prior to adoption of the Final Budget for fiscal year 2026-27; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to establish the date, time, and place of the public hearing on the Tentative Budget as required by Section 10-5-109 of the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS, the Tentative Budget includes a proposed increase in property tax revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to direct publication of notice of the public hearing on the Tentative Budget as required under Sections 10-5-109 and 63G-30-102 of the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that the Tentative Budget, as amended and revised, be available for public inspection during normal business hours in the office of the Town Clerk and on the Town website for at least ten days prior to adoption of the fiscal year 2026-27 Final Budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Alta as follows:

1. The Council acknowledges receipt of the Tentative Budget for fiscal year 2026-27 prepared and submitted by the Budget Officer.
2. The Council adopts the Tentative Budget for fiscal year 2026-27, as prepared and submitted by the Budget Officer, subject to further amendment and revision.
3. The Tentative Budget for fiscal year 2026-27, as revised and amended, shall be available for public inspection during normal business hours at the Office of the Town Clerk in the Town of Alta and on the Town website for at least ten days prior to the adoption of the fiscal year 2026-27 Final Budget.
4. The Council shall review the Tentative Budget and make changes as the Council deems appropriate prior to adoption of the Final Budget for fiscal year 2026-27.
5. The Council shall hold a public hearing on the Tentative Budget, with any revisions the Council has made, prior to adoption of the fiscal year 2026-27 Final Budget, pursuant to Section 10-5-109 of the Utah Code on May 13, 2026, at 4:00 p.m., at the Alta Post Office Building, 10351 East Highway 210, Alta, Utah.
6. The Council directs the appropriate Town officials to publish notice of the public hearing on the Tentative Budget as required under Sections 10-5-109 and 63G-30-102 of the Utah Code.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2026-R-12, shall take effect immediately upon passage as provided herein.


