  - a. The reason for the request indicating the intended use of the vacated property.
  - b. An evaluation of the effects of the vacation on all adjoining properties.
- 5. Also provide the following:
  - a. A written statement from each of the owners of the aforesaid lot or lots indicating whether or not they are in agreement with vacating the public easement.
  - b. A written statement from each of the utility companies indicating whether or not they are in agreement with vacating the public easement.
- 6. Provide a legal mete and bounds description prepared and stamped by a Professional Land Surveyor for the proposed vacation.
