 - c. Will the granting of such relief be materially detrimental to the public health, safety, or welfare, or injurious to the property or improvements of other property owners, or the quiet enjoyment of such property or improvement?
 - d. Do special conditions and circumstances exist which are particular to the land, structure, or building involved and which are not applicable to other lands, structures, or buildings in the same district?
 - e. Would a literal interpretation of the provisions of this ordinance deprive the applicant of rights commonly enjoyed by other properties in the same district under the terms of this ordinance?
 - f. Would special conditions and circumstances result from the action of the applicant?
 - g. Would granting the variance requested confer upon the applicant any special privilege that is denied by this ordinance to other lands, structures or buildings in the same district.
