

CHECK-OUT TO-DO LIST BEFORE LEAVING

- SHUT OFF ALL WATER FAUCETS. TURN OFF THE STOVE AND COFFEE POT, CLEAN ANY GRILLS THAT ARE USED.
- CLEAN OFF ALL COUNTER TOPS, AND WIPE TABLES OFF. WASH DISHES USED, AND RINSE SINKS OUT. REMOVE ALL FOOD ITEMS FROM THE REFRIGERATOR.
- CLEAN UP LITTER FROM GROUNDS, BAG ALL GARBAGE, PUT IT IN THE DUMPSTER, AND INSERT CLEAN BAGS INTO THE TRASH CANS. REMOVE ALL DECORATIONS YOU MAY HAVE PUT UP.
- CLEAN ALL RESTROOMS, BE SURE WATER IS OFF AND THE RESTROOM IS CLEAN FOR THE NEXT RENTERS.
- TURN OFF ALL LIGHTS AND LOCK DOORS AS YOU LEAVE. LOCK THE GATES AS YOU LEAVE. BACK DOOR (PUMP ROOM) LOCKS AND UNLOCKS FROM INSIDE ONLY. LOCK BEFORE LEAVING.
- **DO NOT TURN OFF THE GAS on the tank, or ELECTRIC or LOCK THE KITCHEN DOORS.**

Before deposits are returned – the pavilion and adjoining grounds will be inspected. If there is a need for clean-up, repairs, or missing property (chairs, tables, kitchen tools), you will be responsible to replace.

Be sure that the tables and chairs are clean of stains.

Picnic tables can be taken outside the pavilion, but not any other table or chairs.

NOTICE: Your park gate key will open the gate by the dumpsters. If you want to leave that gate open, it will be at your own risk. If there is a Little League, or AYSO Game and this gate is open, you can expect them to park in this area. It is best to open the gate and drive up to unload, but close the gate behind you.
