

17.64 HEARING ON APPLICATION AND DETERMINATION

(a) Upon receipt of the application and statement referred to in Sec. 17.63 above, the Plan Commission shall hold a public hearing on each application for a conditional use at such time and place as shall be established by the Plan Commission. The hearing shall be conducted and a record of the proceedings shall be preserved in such a manner and according to such procedures as the Plan Commission shall, by rule, prescribe from time to time. The Plan Commission shall make a recommendation to the Village Board regarding whether to grant, deny or grant with additional conditions and guarantees pursuant to Section 17.68 the conditional use, and shall determine the period of the grant of the conditional use, if applicable.

(b) The Village Board shall, at its next regular meeting following the public hearing described in subsection (a) above, determine whether to grant, deny or grant with additional conditions and guarantees pursuant to Section 17.68 the conditional use, and shall determine the period of the grant of the conditional use, if applicable.
