**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A ROADSIDE POLICY
AD HOC COMMITTEE**

2002-1

WHEREAS, the Town of Kinnickinnic has adopted a Roadside Maintenance Ordinance, No. 2009-_____; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance established a Town policy of maintaining a clear zone, a method of controlling and removing vegetation within said clear zone; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board deems it prudent to establish and implement a protocol for viewing rights-of-way and marking vegetation proposed to be cut;

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Town Board of the Town of Kinnickinnic as follows:

1. There is hereby established a Roadside Policy Ad Hoc Committee ("Committee).
2. The Committee shall consist of not less than two Town Board Members and such others person or persons as the Town Board from time to time designates.
3. The Town Board Members shall be compensated at the per diem rate paid Town Board Supervisors for meetings under policies established from time to time by the Town Electors at the Town Meeting. Compensation for any other Committee Members, including Town employees such as Building Inspector, shall be in an amount as established by Resolution and/or Contract from time to time by the Town Board.
4. All meetings of the Ad Hoc Committee shall be noticed as required by law. The Notice shall state the place and time where the Committee will meet and the street or streets to be viewed by the Committee.
5. The Committee shall mark trees it determines should be cut. It shall then report to the Town Clerk the names of property owners abutting right-of-way containing marked vegetation, whereupon the Town Clerk shall give notice to the adjoining property owner of the marking, the intent of the Town to cut the marked vegetation and

the fact the Property Owner has a right to appeal the decision of the Town as provided in Sec. 10 of the Roadside Maintenance Ordinance.
