

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-3
TOWN OF KINNICKINNIC, ST CROIX COUNTY
MINIMUM OF THREE ELECTION OFFICIALS ON
ELECTION DAY

This Ordinance replaces Resolution 2009-7.

The Town Board of the Town of Kinnickinnic, St Croix County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority, under 7.32 Wis Statutes, to adopt this Ordinance.

7.32 Wis Statutes: The municipal governing body has the specific authority to reduce the required number of Election Officials at a Polling Place from 7 or 5 (in a municipality where voting machines are used) to no less than three, and the Town Board has determined it would be advantageous to the Town to have only as many Elections Officials on duty as are needed for a given Election.

This Ordinance, adopted by a majority vote of the Town Board, declares as follows:

There shall be a minimum of three Election Officials, per shift, on duty at every Election. At the discretion of the Town Clerk, the requisite number of Election Officials may be increased for any Election. However, the number of Election Officials working at a given Election shall always be an odd number.

This Ordinance is effective upon posting. The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this Ordinance as required under 60.80 Wis. Statutes.
