

ORDINANCE NO. 3.08
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHAM
TO ESTABLISH PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON TOWN ROADS

The Town Board of the Town of Brigham, Iowa County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles shall be prohibited on the following locations in the Town of Brigham:
 - a. Both sides of West Blue Mounds Road within 200 feet north and 200 feet south of 4668 West Blue Mounds Road during the months of December, January, February, and March.
 - b. Both sides of Mounds Park Road between entrance of Blue Mound State Park and the intersection with Ryan Road during the months of December, January, February, and March.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$40 if paid within 7 days; \$50 if paid within 14 days; and \$100 thereafter.
