

other than those with mutual aid with the Town of Tilden, shall be responsible for the full costs billed to the town for the fire call. This section shall not apply to the costs of any other department responding at the request of an authorized department under mutual aid.

Section 5: Billing and Payment Procedure. The costs of fire calls as outlined above shall be billed by the Town Clerk to the property owner and paid to the Town Treasurer within sixty (60) days of the date of the bill. The failure to pay the bill within sixty (60) days will result in interest being charged at the rate of 1.5% per month from the date of the bill. Those bills remaining outstanding, including interest, for more than ninety (90) days as of November 1 of any year shall become a lien against the real estate from which fire protection was provided and shall be placed on the tax roll as a delinquent special charge pursuant to Section 66.60 of Wisconsin Statutes.
