## RESOLUTION 2009-2

**Whereas**, the Town of Tilden has drafted a comprehensive land plan; and involved the public in every state of planning; and

**Whereas**, the Town of Tilden, appointed citizens to plan for the future of Tilden by recognizing problems and drafting and developing ordinances, to be known as the Town of Tilden Community Preservation Study Committee; and

**Whereas**, the Town of Tilden has sent two surveys to its citizens asking for public input for the planning of the future of Tilden; and

**Whereas**, the Tilden Newsletter has been sent to all citizens and land owners since March 2000, at least once a year plus a special addition devoted to land use sent April 2008 to keep them apprised of the progress of the land plan and inviting public input; and

**Whereas**, the Town of Tilden, held a public hearing, March 13, 1999 on land planning for Tilden, with the Chippewa County Land Conservation Department leading and involvement from the Chippewa County Zoning Department; and

**Whereas**, the Town of Tilden Community Preservation Study Committee and Plan Commission has given due notice for each of its meeting to involve the public and placed public input on the agenda for meetings; and

**Whereas**, public did attend meetings and expressed their ideas and concerns; and

**Whereas**, the Town of Tilden has developed a town web site, where the Comprehensive Land Plan is to be placed and due notice sent to its citizens;

**Therefore**, the Town Board of the Town of Tilden, now hereby resolves to further involves the public by holding a public hearing announced by a class I notice and providing for comment on the draft comprehensive plan, before such plan is sent to the State of Wisconsin.
