Chapter 2 (Revised 12-11-2024)

Penalty Ordinance

Penalty - Unless otherwise specified or stated in a chapter, any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a penalty as follows:

A. <u>First Offense Penalty</u>. Any person who shall violate any provision of the Tilden Code of Ordinances subject to a penalty shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than thirty Dollars (\$30.00) twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) together with costs of prosecution.

B. <u>Second Offense Penalty.</u> Any person found guilty of violating any part of the Tilden Code of Ordinances who shall previously have been convicted of a violation of the same ordinance within one year shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each such offense, together with the costs of prosecution.

C. <u>Continued Violation.</u> Each violation and each day a violation continues or occurs shall constitute a separate offense. Nothing in this ordinance shall preclude the Town from maintaining any appropriate action to prevent or remove a violation of any provisions of this ordinance.
