DOGS:

Dogs may not run at large: Owners are responsible for their dogs, and need to be on a leash when off theirowner's property. Walkers and bikers should not have dogs chasing them.

<u>ALL dogs in the State of Wisconsin MUST be licensed</u>. Licenses are good for one year starting January 1st and expire December 31st. <u>Dogs over 5 months</u>, <u>not licensed by April 1st will be charged a latefee of \$25.00</u>in addition to the regular license fees.

<u>Licenses will not be issued without proof of rabies vaccination or a waiver</u> <u>from a veterinarian</u>. Vaccination papers will be returned with the license. Any dog that is in your possession for more than 7 days is considered your dog, per State Statute.

<u>Tilden does NOT have a contract with the Chippewa Humane Society</u>. If you find a dog in Tilden, the CHS will not accept it. Contact the constable or another town officer if you find a dog. Because Tilden is not part of the Chippewa Humane Society it is Town Policy that all dogsfound are held in Tilden. All dogs are held for 7 days and then are dealt with. If you find a dog in the Town of Tilden contact Constable Tim Swoboda at 715-577-8524.

Owners of unlicensed Dogs will be taken to small claims court for failure to license and vaccinate their dog(s). The court costs (\$150+) will be added to the regular license fees plus a \$25.00 late fee.

To licensed your dog(s), Make checks payable to: Town of Tilden, 10302 110th St., Chippewa Falls, WI 54729. Include the following with the correct license fee: Owner's Name and Address, Dogs Name and Breed, Proof of Rabies Vaccination from a Veterinarian. Fees: \$8.00 for spayed or neutered dogs, \$13 for intact dogs and \$60 for a kennel license up to 12 dog - \$7 for each additional dog over 12.For questions, contact Shelley Schemenauer, Treasurer at 715-829-3120.

Why should I license my dog every year? Under Wisconsin State Statues, Chapter 174.051(1)the owner of the dog more than 5 months of age on January 1 of any year, or 5 months of age withing the licensed year shall annually, or on or before the date the dog becomes 5 months of age, pay the dog license & obtain a license.
