# The Tilden Code of Ordinances Chapter 21

#### **Section 6:**

For the purpose of access of emergency vehicles, it is <u>recommended</u> that:

- **A.** The remaining slope of the driveway may have a grade not to exceed 6% upward or down-ward from the roadbed level.
- **B.** Ample width; equivalent of one standard road lane (11) eleven feet.
- **C.** The removal of all obstructions, all directions, including overhead.
- **D.** Retaining walls or drop offs should be at least (4) four feet from the traveled portion of the driveway.
- **E.** Curves or corners should take into consideration easy access for emergency vehicles that cannot make tight corners.
- **F.** Conditions created by adverse weather, including rain, snow, ice, and heat be considered.

Failure to meet these recommendations may negate your ability to receive emergency services.
