We have identified several needs, including addressing:

- The deteriorated pavement
- The deteriorated structure over Pickerel Creek
- Multiple deteriorated culvert pipes
- · Guardrail that does not meet current safety standards
- The operational issue caused by traffic turning left at County R
- · The safety concern at the Resort Road intersection

Proposed improvements include:

- Resurfacing the existing asphalt pavement
- Performing deck repairs and an asphalt overlay on the structure over Pickerel Creek
- · Replacing culvert pipes
- Replacing guardrail to current standards
- Converting the section of 4-lane undivided highway near County R to a 2-lane section with left turn lanes
- Adding a left turn lane for northbound traffic at Resort Road

The objective of the meeting is to provide an overview of the project and gather input about the proposed improvements.

This project will <u>not</u> include work on the structure over the Labutzke Channel. This work will be a part of a separate project. A separate public involvement meeting will be scheduled at a later date for this project.
