

TOWN OF WASHINGTON  
BUILDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

The Town of Washington enforces the WI Uniform Dwelling code for residential as well as the ICC for commercial construction projects. Enforcement includes new construction and additions and alterations to existing buildings, both residential and commercial. Accessory buildings such as sheds and garages are also enforced. AG buildings are exempt from building permit requirements.

New home applications are completed on line at [dsps.wi.gov](http://dsps.wi.gov) All other applications are completed using the attached application form. New construction and additions will require a zoning permit from the Green County zoning office prior to a building permit being issued. ALL projects will require plans to be submitted for review.

Construction CANNOT be started prior to obtaining the proper permits. Starting without a permit may be subject to double permit fees.
