The Town Board of the Town of Washington, Green County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.07 (8), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.


This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the installation of stop signs on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Stop signs shall be placed on Pierce road in the town at each entrance of that road onto Washington road.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall erect stop signs as provided in this ordinance on or before the effective date of this ordinance.*


This ordinance is effective on posting *on* January 13, 2026,
