

ORDINANCE NO. 2013- 09

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE A-90-1 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAVALLE, WISCONSIN RELATING TO WELL ABANDONMENT AND PRIVATE WELL PERMITS.

Whereas, the Village Board desires to amend the Village ordinance to reduce the number of required water sampling tests for a private well permit from two to one.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of LaValle, Sauk County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:


Section 1. Section 10.15(5)(2) of Ordinance A-90-1 of the Village of LaValle shall be repealed, amended, and re-created to read as follows:


(2) The well construction and pump installation have a history of producing bacteriologically safe water as evidenced by at least one sampling. No exception shall be made for this condition for unsafe wells, unless the Department of Natural Resources approves, in writing, the continued use of the well.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication according to law.
