A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY EXCEPTION TO THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the Village Board has accepted the findings of MSA Professional Services that the Village's Well No. 1 contains unsafe amounts of benzene and that emergency mitigation and repair measures are necessary to protect the health, safety, and public welfare of the Village.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Board of the Village of La Valle, Sauk County, Wisconsin that:

- 1. An emergency exists that endangers the public health and welfare of the Village and its residents and pursuant to the authority granted by Wis. Stat. Section 62.15(1b) the Village Board determines that the provisions of Wis. Stat. Section 62.15(1) and Wis. Stat. Section 281.41 are not mandatory for the repair and reconstruction of the municipal well.
- The Village President and the Village Clerk are authorized to sign any
 applications or associated documents to seek or obtain funding from potential
 federal, state, or other programs that may be available to assist with this
 emergency.
- 3. MSA Professional Services is authorize to submit the Emergency Community Water Assistance Grant (ECWAG) to the United States Department of Agriculture for temporary water treatment at Well No. 1 and future Well No. 2.
