## La Valle Waterworks is now treating the water to remove benzene.

## New Treatment System in La Valle

La Valle Waterworks is now treating all of the Village's water with a new Granular Activated Carbon (GAC) treatment system. The water coming out of this treatment system has benzene below the maximum contaminant level (MCL) of 5 micrograms per liter ( $\mu$ g/L). The water in the mains and pipes still contains benzene above the MCL. The Water Operator is working to flush the water system of the high benzene water. A public notice will be issued when the water in the distribution system is below the MCL. The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) recommends that you avoid long-term use of the water for drinking until the water in the distribution system is below the MCL to reduce potential for health risks.
