

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR  
LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGES  
AND CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO PRODUCTS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Ashford has the powers and duties associated with the issuance of liquor licenses under chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Town has the authority to set the fees for the various types of liquor licenses authorized under chapter 125, provided that such fees are not less than the minimum nor more than the maximum fees authorized under chapter 125; and

WHEREAS, the Town has authority to establish a fee for the issuance of licenses for the sale of cigarettes and other tobacco products under sec. 134.65(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Ashford does hereby ordain as follows:

1. No license for the sale or serving of alcohol beverages or for the sale or other handling of cigarettes or other tobacco products may be delivered to any applicant for such license until the applicant files with the Clerk a receipt showing payment of the fee or fees prescribed by, or determined under, this Ordinance.
2. The fee for a Class "A" beer license shall be \$20.
3. The fee for a Class "B" beer license shall be \$75.
4. The fee for a "Class A" liquor license shall be \$75.
5. The fee for a "Class B" liquor license shall be \$175.
6. The fee for temporary Class "B" beer and temporary "Class B" wine licenses shall be \$5.
7. The fee for an operator's license for a person serving alcohol beverages in an establishment with a Class "A," "Class A," Class "B," "Class B" or "Class C" license shall be \$10.
8. The fee for a license to sell, expose for sale, possess with intent to sell, exchange, barter, dispose of or give away any cigarettes or other tobacco products shall be \$5.

9. In the event that the range of permissible fees provided under chapters 125 or 134 of the Wisconsin Statutes on the effective date of this Ordinance for any type of license referred to in this Ordinance is subsequently amended, the fee prescribed under this Ordinance shall be automatically adjusted such that it bears the same relation in dollars to the minimum fee permitted by the statute as amended as it does to the minimum fee permitted by the statute on the effective date of this Ordinance; provided, however, that the adjusted fee shall in no event exceed that maximum fee permitted by statute.

10. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the calendar date immediately following the date set forth below.
