## MAINTENANCE OF 3 LOCAL CEMETERIES

**1. The local cemeteries are:** Wheelock Village Cemetery, Sulphur Springs Cemetery (the only active cemetery) and South Wheelock Cemetery. Services include mowing and trimming, and also the following:

- a. Open cemeteries May 1 (remove any fallen tree branches, etc.).  
Close cemeteries right after Veterans Day November 11 (removing flags, old arrangements).
- b. Remove and place any damaged flags throughout the season. (Volunteers to place & remove prior to opening & closing. Extras available at town office)
- c. Keep the Town Clerk informed at all times of issues that may come up, and recommend any further actions (leaning stones, monument repairs, water repairs, trimming, cutting or removing trees and shrubs).

### 2. Requirements

Insurance

The Contractor's policies shall name the Town of Wheelock as an additional insured.

Experience providing cemetery maintenance for a municipality

Valid Driver's License

Excellent care and attention to prevent damage to gravestones

Communicate effectively with town employees/officials, and the public at all times

## MAINTENANCE OF OUTLYING WHEELOCK CEMETERIES

### 3. Maintenance of two outlying Wheelock cemeteries: West Wheelock and Drown

The goal is to keep brush from growing back in, not to create a park-like environment.

***This may be bid for both cemeteries together, on a per mowing basis, in case only one mowing per year is needed if its dry with slow growth, or two are needed because it is a strong growing season. To be determined by the Town.***

## SEXTON

### 1. The Sexton shall coordinate burials at the Town's Sulfur Springs Cemetery

- a. Work closely and compassionately with the persons/family seeking the burial.
- b. Oversee the burial: Marking out grave location, digging and re-covering
- c. Order/place the four corner stones of each new lot sold.
- d. Direct all monies received (grave openings, sale of lots, etc.) and all related paperwork to the town clerk/treasurer within 5 days.

- e. Date and sign all burial permits and bring them to the town clerk within five days of the burial.
- f. Sexton shall be consistent with the amended [Wheelock Cemetery Policy](#)

**2. Sexton Requirements**

Insurance

The Contractor’s policies shall name the Town of Wheelock as an additional insured.

Experience working with municipalities as sexton

Knowledge of best practices for burial and of cemetery laws and regulations in Vermont

Valid Driver’s License

Excellent organizational and coordination skills

Excellent attention to detail and accuracy

Communicate effectively with town employees/officials, and the public at all times

Good judgement and the ability to prioritize

Tact and compassion in dealing with people in bereavement

**Bids must be received by Tuesday Jan. 20, 2026 at noon.** Bids may be sent via email to [wheelocktown@gmail.com](mailto:wheelocktown@gmail.com) or hand delivered in a sealed envelope to the town office address above. Please write “CEMETERY BID” on the outside of the envelope.

**Please provide separate bid amounts for Cemetery Maintenance (Local and Remote) and for Sexton work. And note that for the remote cemeteries, please bid per mowing (of both cemeteries together). The Town may require two mowings, depending on town budget and the weather and growing season.**

**Please include a copy of current certificate of insurance:** (1) Commercial General Liability insurance coverage with a policy limit of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 in aggregate; (2) Business Automobile Liability coverage with total liability limits of at least \$1,000,000; and (3) Statutory Workers’ Compensation insurance. If Contractor is not required by law to carry workers’ compensation insurance, in place of proof of workers’ compensation insurance Contractor may provide a fully executed Non-Employee Work Agreement specifying the particular provision of 21 V.S.A §601(14)(F) that exempts Contractor from having to carry such coverage.
