

- New logo depicts historic High Bridge
- Town of Somerset established in 1856
- First train crossed the High Bridge on June 19, 1911
- 2,683 feet long; 185 feet above the St. Croix River; nearly 1-mile long span
- Six huge piers and five large steel arches built by Kelly Atkinson Construction Company of Chicago; engineered by C.A.P. Turner
- Added to National Registry of Historic Places in 1977
- Trespassing prohibited Trains still run daily


