TOWNSHIP OF TREGO ORDINANCE #113 – ATV ROAD DESIGNATION Amendment #1

AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW ATV ACCESS FROM A RESIDENCE AND/OR LODGING ESTABLISHMENT TO LOCAL BUSINESSES AND TRAILS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF TREGO, WASHBURN COUNTY, WISCONSIN.

The Town Board of the Township of Trego, Washburn County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: INTENT

The intent of the ordinance is to provide a means for persons to travel from a residence or lodging establishment within the limits of the Township to Trego, Washburn County, Wisconsin, to reach local business and trails.

SECTION II: STATUTORY AUTHORITY

This ordinance is adopted as authorized under s. 23.33 (8)(b).

SECTION III: CONDITIONS

This ordinance designates the roadways and/or shoulders of highways for ATV travel by persons residing in or staying at a lodging establishment within the limits of the Township of Trego, Washburn County, to travel the distance that is necessary to reach business establishments and trails subject to the following conditions:

A. Driver Requirements

If you are at least 12 and born on or after 01-01-88, you must possess a valid ATV safety certificate to operate an ATV.

If you were born before 01-01-88, certification or supervision is not required.

B. Speed

There will be a 15 mph speed limit on all town roads.

C. ATV Requirements

All ATVs must have running lights and a brake light.

D. Enforcement

This ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement official operating within the Township of Trego.

E. Effective Date

This ordinance is effective from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
